

## **Bracket and Club Championships Point Rules**

### **Eligibility**

All properly entered competitors at point score accumulating meetings can accrue points.

### **Points Accrual**

1. There must be at least 4 competitors in a bracket at any race meeting who must all make at least one legal pass\* during racing (not qualifying) at that meeting for race points to be allocated to the competitors in that bracket.

\*As defined in the IHRA rules current on the date that the event takes place

**\*\*Note:** This table only shows common outcomes, there are several other combinations possible, e.g. If you do not accept the Christmas tree under your own power you get 0 for that round. The 8 points shown in the table are for people that do not make the final but have 3 wins for the night.

### **Bracket Champions (including Juniors)**

1. The Bracket Champion for any given bracket will be the racer who accumulates the most points for the calendar year season in the bracket in which they have competed (Note these points are only drawn from the normal rounds i.e. Nostalgia and All Bikes do not count towards point's total). Points are not transferable between brackets where a racer competes in more than one bracket during the season.

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2. Where additional brackets are created at any meeting due to large fields or any other reason, points shall be accumulated for racers in the bracket where they originally qualified (i.e. "Top Ten" competitor's points are accrued in Competition).
3. Bracket Championships will recognise and reward Runner-up.

### **Club Champion**

1. The Club Champion will gain the Championship through the accumulation of points, providing they have maintained a current Ordinary or Honorary membership in the *Central Queensland Drag Racing Association Incorporated* for at least six (6) months of that calendar year season.
2. The Club Champion will be the racer who accumulates the most points for the calendar year season drawn from any bracket (Note these points are only drawn from the normal rounds i.e. Nostalgia and All Bikes do not count towards point's total).
3. If a racer competes in more than one bracket only one bracket with the most points are transferred to the Club Champion points tally.

### **Junior Club Champion**

1. Only awarded if more than one Junior Bracket in the season.
2. Rules as per club champion.

### **Point Score Record Keeping**

A member of the CQDRA approved by the Association, in consultation with the Management Committee, will keep an official record of points accumulated by racers.

### **Adjudication**

Any issues relating to the point score system must first be directed to the Point Score Record Keeper. If an issue remains unresolved direct it to the President of the CQDRA and he or she will conduct a review of all the facts of the case on behalf of the competitor, in conjunction with the Management Committee, and the Point Score Record Keeper. The judgement of the Committee is final and their decision will stand.

### **Rule Changes**

Changes to these rules can only be made on recommendation from the Management Committee at a properly convened General Meeting of the CQDRA.

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
